Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health: A Challenge to Roe

- **December 1, 2021:** Supreme Court heard oral arguments in *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization*, a case about a Mississippi law banning abortion after 15 weeks
- June 22, 2022: Dobbs ruling released
 - The Supreme Court upheld the ban, overturning Roe
 - Each individual state now can decide whether to keep abortion legal, or not




Guttmacher Interactive Map

State of Abortion Care in Michigan

- Michigan's 1931 Criminal Abortion Law is currently on the books, which bans abortion except if the life of the mother is at risk
- Lawsuits by Governor Whitmer and Planned Parenthood to obtain a Michigan Supreme Court ruling that abortion is a state constitutional right
- State Ballot Initiative will bring Reproductive Rights to November ballot
