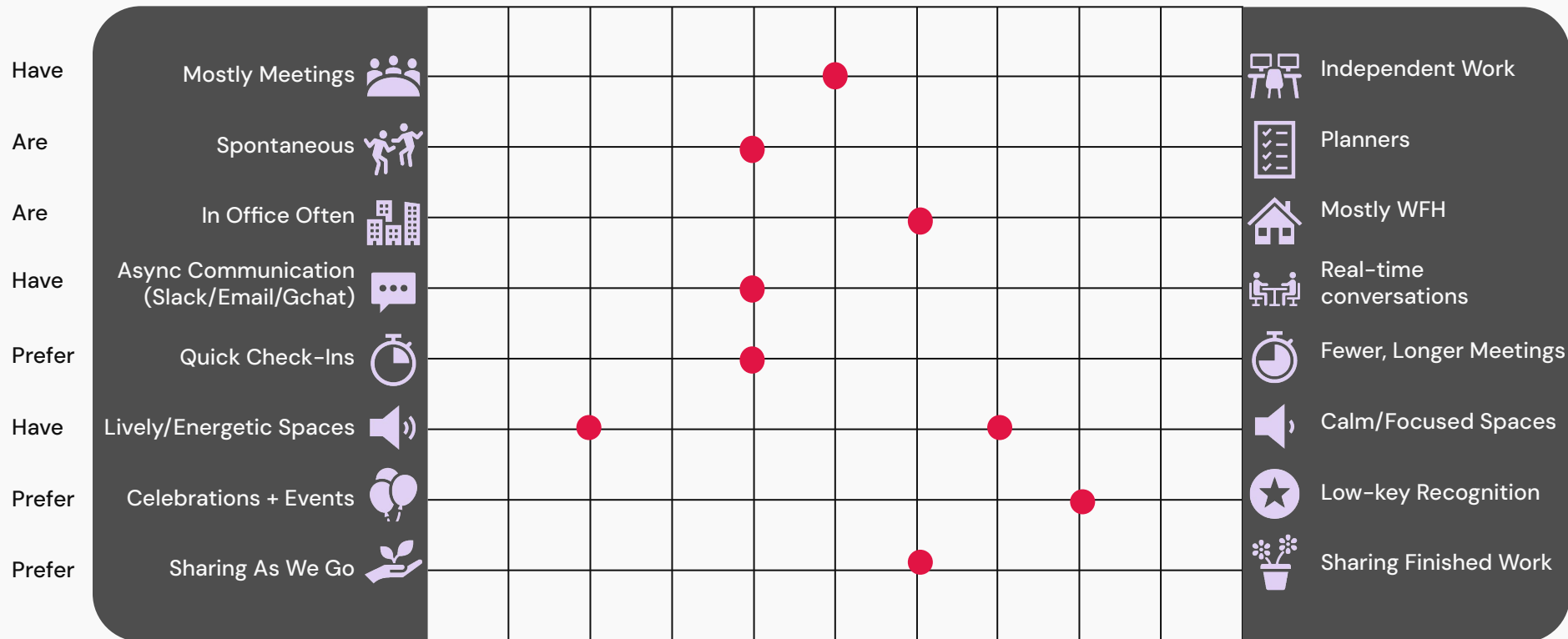
Arts Initiative

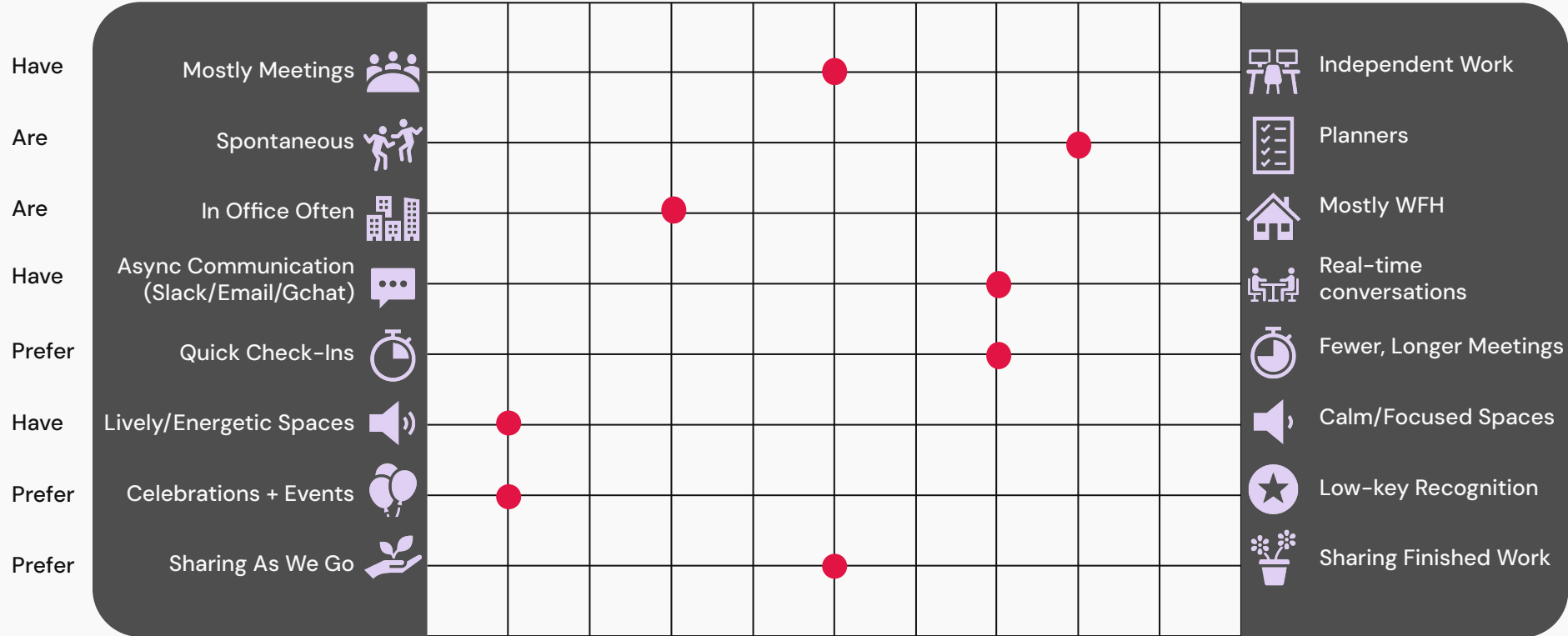
CEO CONNECTS: Capacity building with 87+ units, coordinating isolated programs into campus-wide networks. **CEO BRIDGES:** Bidirectional relationships between Michigan K-12 communities & U-M for statewide impact. **CEO INTEGRATES:** Reducing duplication & increasing efficiency to extend U-M outreach beyond any one program. Here's part of our story:

- **Campus Visits - First Points of Belonging:** Campus visits create early moments of possibility, where students engage with U-M faculty and staff and begin to see it as a place where they belong
- **Experiencing U-M Through Watson:** Scholarship that funds U-M summer program tuition to provide immersive academic experiences by faculty and staff for Michigan middle and high school students
- **U-M Student Leaders - Near-Peer Influence:** Visible, relatable role models share how they actively navigate life and academics at U-M while becoming future outreach workforce leaders themselves
- **MCAC - The Power of Recent Alumni:** College advisers serve in Michigan schools to provide high-touch support in applications & financial aid, translating their lived experience into trusted guidance

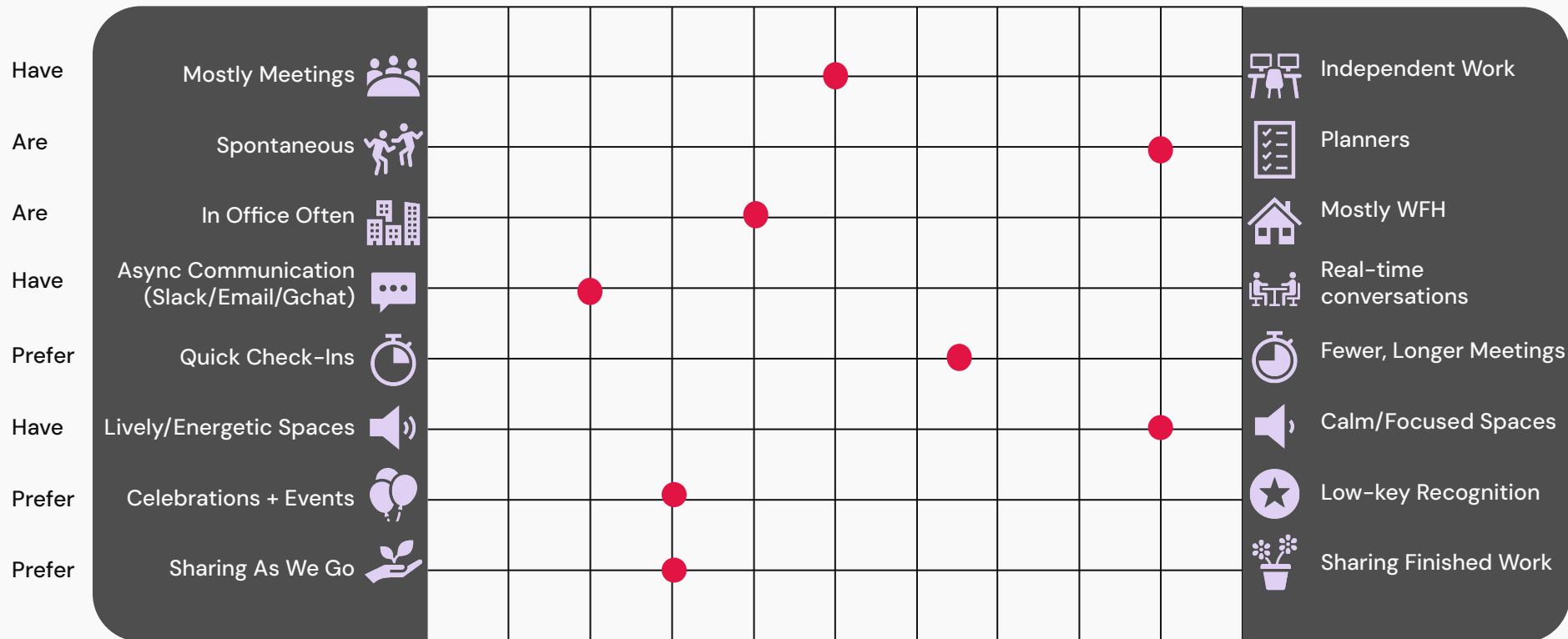
In alignment with Graham's vision, mission, and values, as well as U-M's three-fold commitment to research, education, and service, our strategic priorities are to:

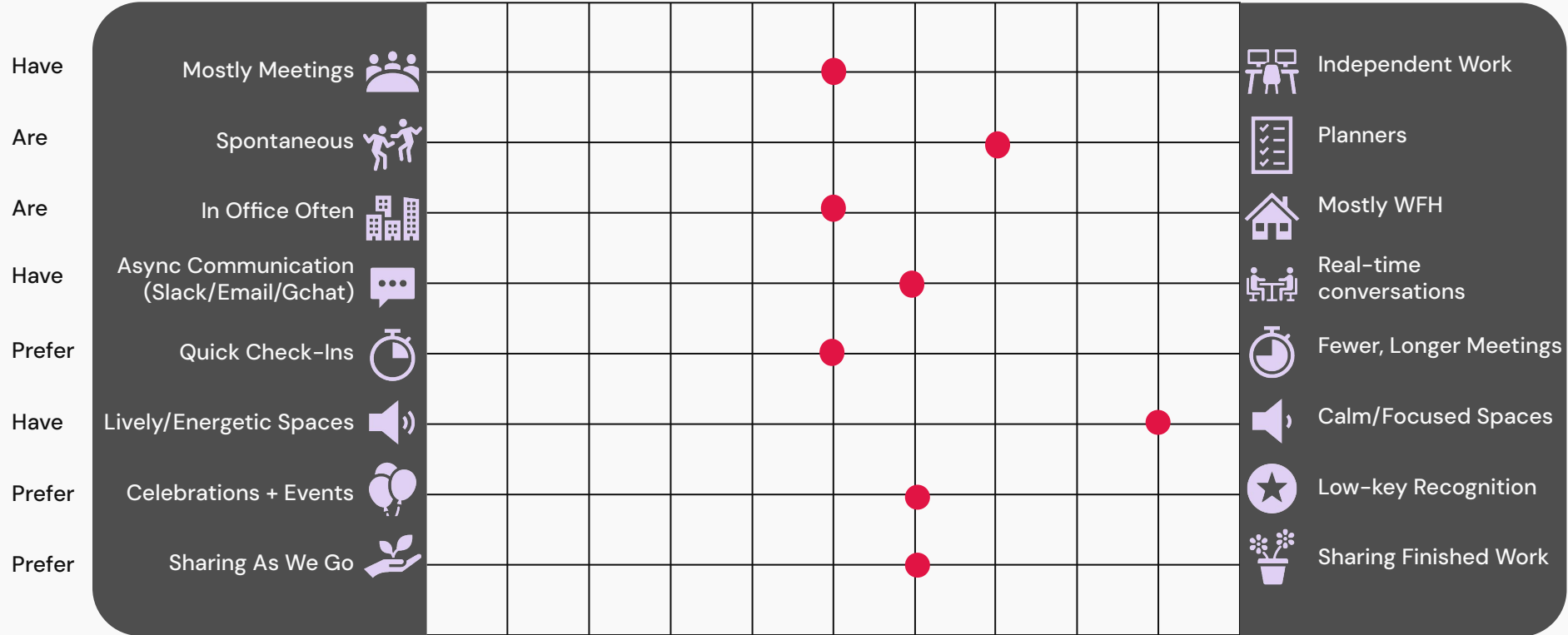
The Michigan Program for Advancing Cultural Transformation (M-PACT) is a federally funded, university-wide faculty initiative. It aims to drive transformative research, life-changing teaching, and accessible clinical care that will support the health of ALL, including a strong commitment to communities who have been underserved. By partnering with faculty throughout their careers, M-PACT strengthens the capacity of those who serve as catalysts for change in academic and healthcare environments.

Utilizing a cohort-based model for hiring and retention, M-PACT partners with [eleven schools and colleges](#) in the biomedical and health sciences and offers comprehensive career development for faculty. Our program provides robust mentorship and sponsorship, cultivates leadership skills, and prepares both mentors and mentees to excel as future leaders and force multipliers across the biomedical and health sciences.

We are committed to ongoing, evidence-backed program evaluation in order to continuously refine, expand, and share our impact—across the University of Michigan and beyond.

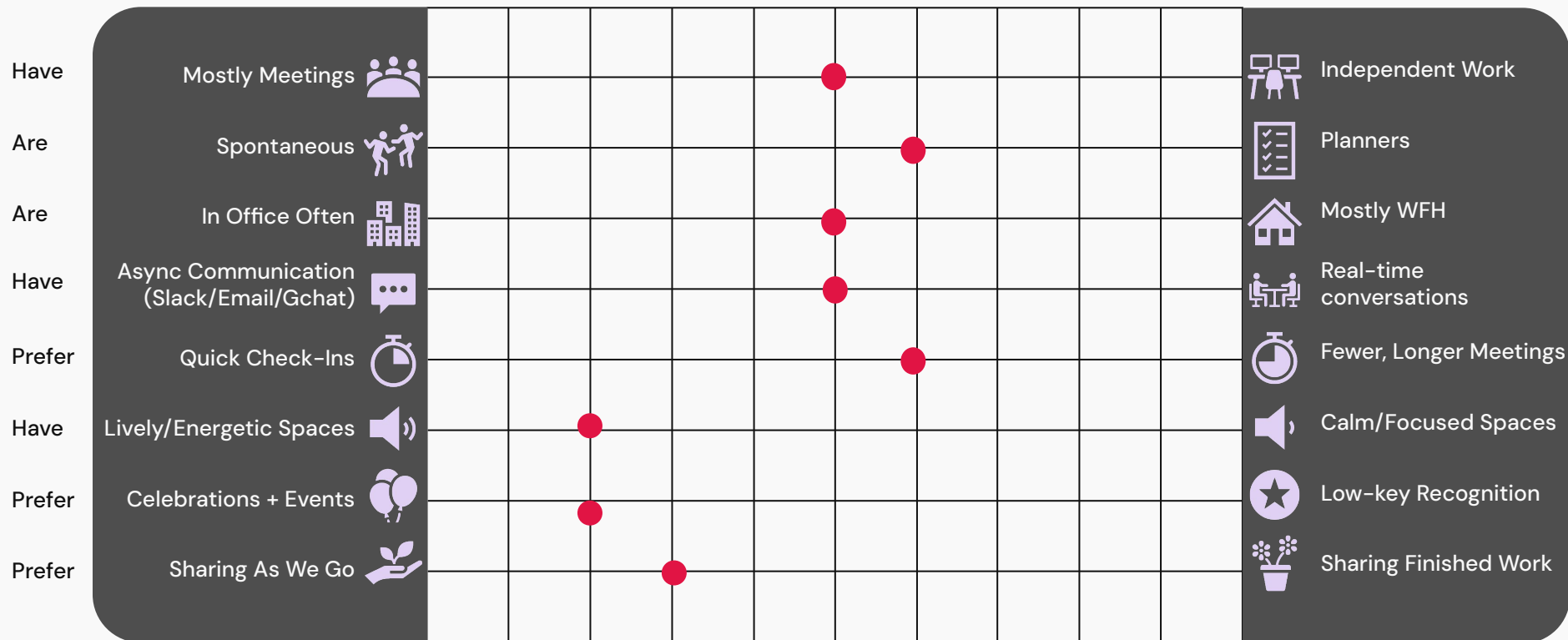
