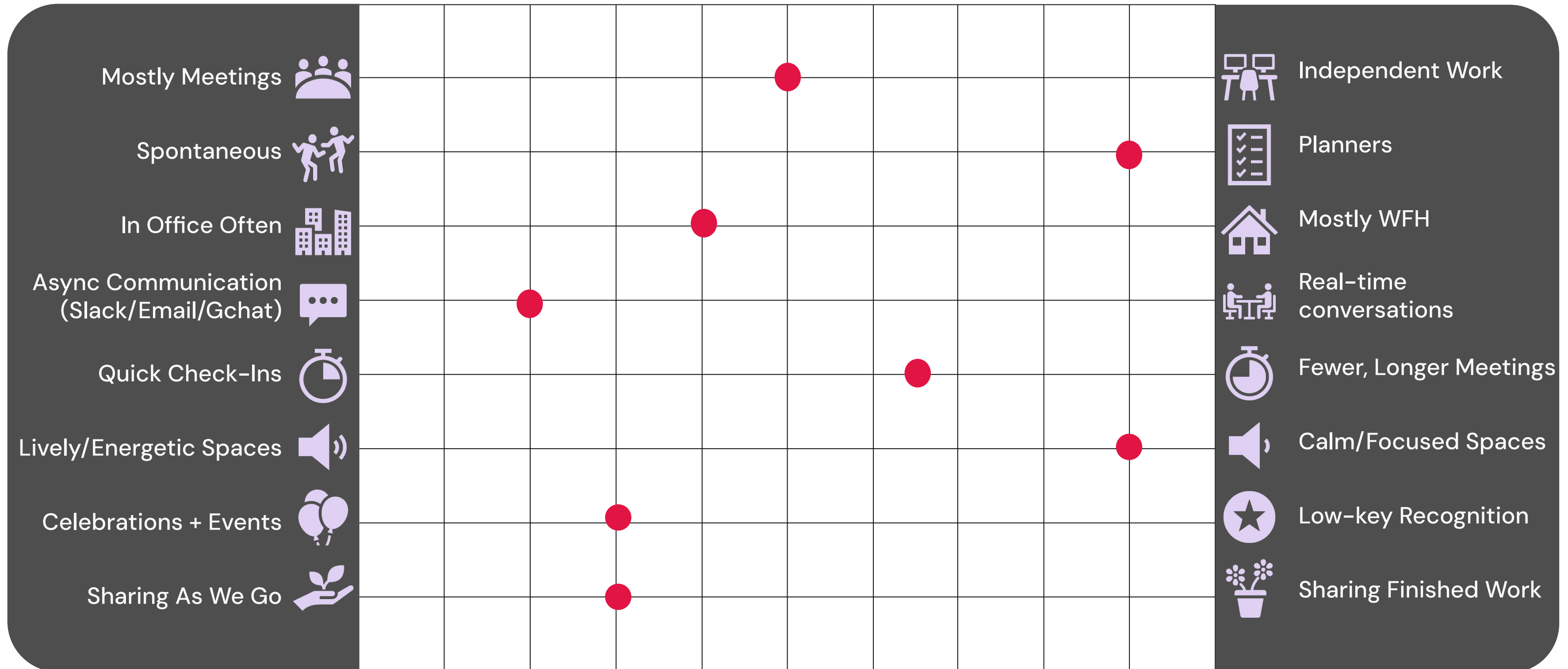
In alignment with Graham's vision, mission, and values, as well as U-M's three-fold commitment to research, education, and service, our strategic priorities are to:
